

Local stakeholder update June – July 2016

Outlined below is a summary of progress on site in June and a look ahead to activity due to take place during July.

JUNE

- The installation of the solar cells on the roof of the recyclables bulking facility was completed.
- The new weighbridges were commissioned and are now in use. The old weighbridges have been removed from the site.
- The perimeter road to the north and east of the site is now in use.
- The exit road for the community recycling centre opened to the public.
- The new community recycling centre office opened.
- Work continued on:
 - Piling for the gasification facility
 - Erecting the steel frame of the anaerobic digestion facility building.

JULY

- Work will continue on:
 - Piling for the gasification facility.
 - The steel frame of the anaerobic digestion facility building.
- Work is due to begin to install the wall cladding for the anaerobic digestion facility building.
- The layout of the community recycling centre continues to be restricted; there are fewer parking spaces available and the site is accepting the full range of materials, with a reduced number of containers. As a result, waiting times are affected, particularly at busy times. Staff are working to minimise disruption and will be on hand to assist site users.
- Surrey County Council is extending opening hours at the community recycling centre to help alleviate waiting times. From 1st July until 30th September 2016 the recycling centre will open 8am to 6pm on weekdays. It will also open 8am to 4pm on Saturdays until the end of construction. Sunday opening times are unchanged (9am to 4pm).
