

Local stakeholder update – July – June 2019

Below is a summary of the work that has taken place over the last month, and the work planned for the following month.

JUNE

- Hot commissioning continued on the AD facility, with volumes of food waste being gradually increased.
- The first electricity generated from food waste was produced via the combined heat and power engines. The electricity will be used to power the site, with excess going into the National Grid.
- Work continued with commissioning parts of the gasification facility, such as the bunker that will be used to store the refuse-derived fuel.
- Work to complete the admin building and offices continued.

JULY

- Hot commissioning will continue on the AD facility throughout the month as the equipment is calibrated to ensure optimum performance.
- Work will continue on the admin building and offices.
- The steam turbine will be commissioned ready to be synchronised to the National Grid.
- Commissioning of the gasification facility will continue.
